



LIST OF DOCUMENTS CONFIRMING ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY ACCEPTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF LOWER SILESIA

University of Lower Silesia accepts the following documents certifying the English language proficiency on the level sufficient to undertake studies at the University:

- a) Diploma Degree Certification in English Language or in Applied Linguistic in English,
- b) Diploma and /or Degree Certification, issued by home university or foreign university, if the language of instruction was English,
- c) A document equivalent to the Polish Secondary School Certificate (Matura exam) issued abroad, if the language of instruction was English,
- d) International Baccalaureate Diploma,
- e) Official certificate proving rights to practice the English language translator profession,
- f) First Certificate in English (FCE) – grade A or B,
- g) Certificate in Advanced English (CAE),
- h) Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE),
- i) Business English Certificate (BEC) Vantage, Business English Certificate (BEC) Higher, Certificate in English for International Business and Trade (CEIBT) – issued by University of Cambridge Local Examinations Syndicate and University of Cambridge ESOL Examinations.
- j) International English Language Testing System (IELTS) – above 6 points – certificate issued by University of Cambridge Local Examinations Syndicate, the British Council and Education, Australia.
- h) Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) – paper-based test (TOEFL PBT) – minimum 500 points, computer-based test (TOEFL CBT) – minimum 173 points, Internet-based test (TOEFL IBT) – minimum 87 points – certificate issued by Educational Testing Service, Princeton, USA.
- i) English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) – Higher Intermediate Level, Advanced Level – certificate issued by City & Guilds Pitman Qualifications (Pitman Qualifications Institute).
- j) International English for Speakers of Other Languages (IESOL) – level: “Communicator”, “Expert” or “Mastery” – certificate issued by City & Guilds (City & Guilds Pitman Qualifications).
- k) Spoken English Test (SET) for Business – Stage B level “Communicator”, Stage C level “Expert”, Stage C level “Mastery” – certificates issued by City & Guilds (City & Guilds Pitman Qualifications).
- l) English for Business Communication (EBC) – Level 2, Level 3 – certificate issued by City & Guilds (City & Guilds Pitman Qualifications).

- m) Test of English for International Communication (TOEIC) – minimum 750 points from test – certificates issued by Educational Testing Service, Princeton, USA,
- n) London Chamber of Commerce and Industry (LCCI): English for Business Level 2 – credit or distinction, English for Business Level 3 – credit or distinction, English for Business Level 4 – certificates issued by London Chamber of Commerce and Industry Examination Board.
- o) B2 Certificate in English, B2 Certificate in English for Business Purposes, C1 Certificate in English – TELC exams (The European Language Certificates) managed by WBT (Weiterbildungs – Testsysteme GmbH)
